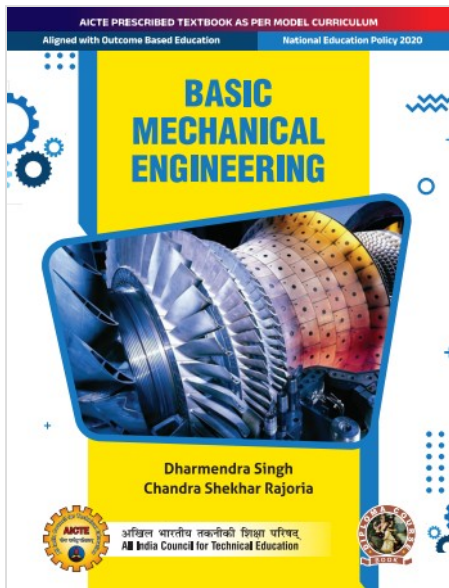




Basic Mechanical Engineering
