The motivation for coming out with this compilation, is because, students are usually introduced to the required pre-requisitions in earlier courses. For example, the 'Engineering Mathematics', course is likely to have introduced Calculus (integration, differential equation, difference equation), Laplace Transform, Fourier series, Fourier Transform, Z-Transform. The courses on 'Analog Electronic Circuits and 'Network Analysis', is likely to have introduced basic electronic circuits including resistors, capacitors, inductors and Operational amplifiers, that require the need to obtain the transfer function, the response to a given output. The student is usually introduced to another independent programming language (C/C++/ Python/Matlab /Sci-lab/ R programming/any other), where the emphasis is on the syntax of the language. In this Book, we provide a brief introduction to every pre-requisite; explain the concept, together with few examples for every concept. In addition, wherever applicable, different methods of arriving at the given solution are also included. The concept of Digital Signal Processing

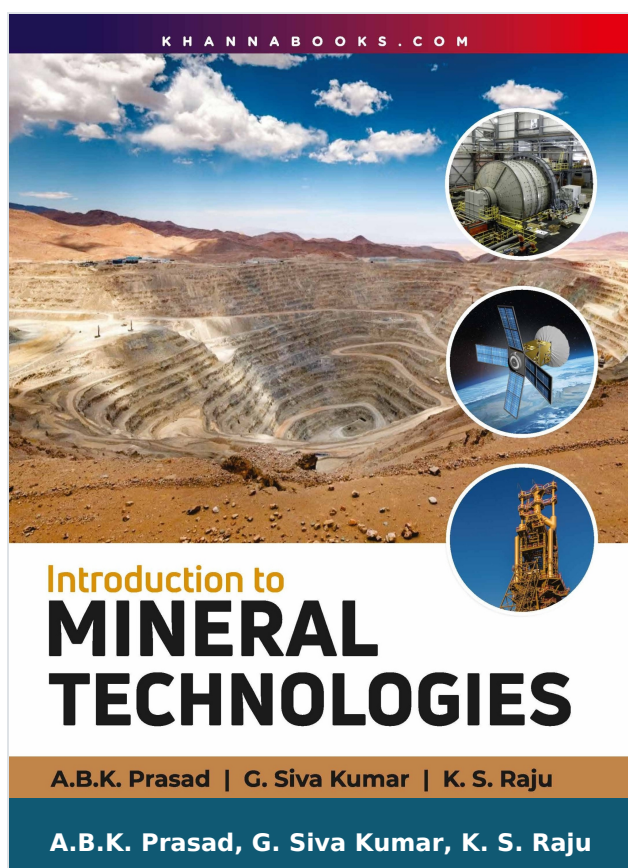

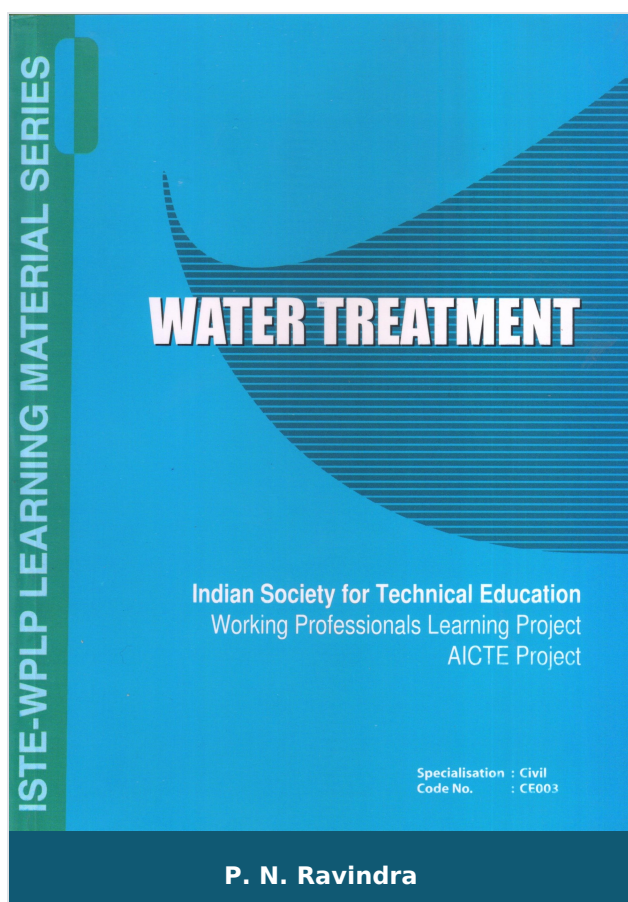
