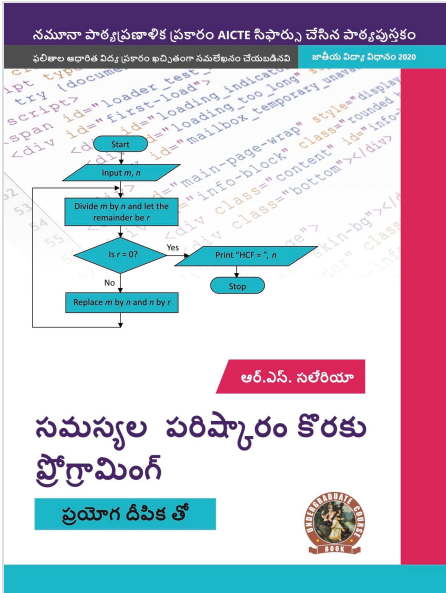




# Programming for Problem Solving (with Lab Manual)
